*Shine in your Church gathered today.*

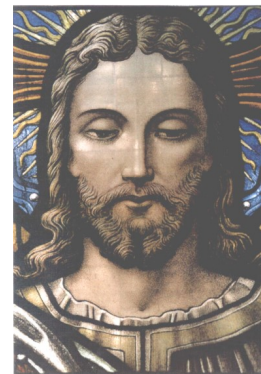
Longing for peace, our world is troubled.

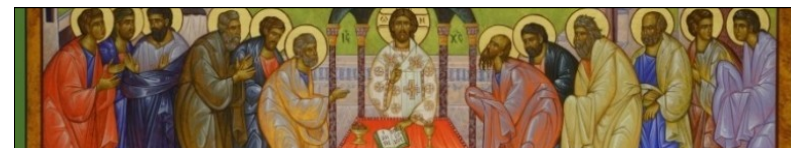
