sinners to redeem and save. Alleluia!

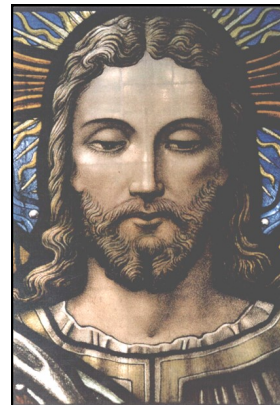
But the pain that he endured, Alleluia!
