and keep me in the way of your truth, for you are my God, my Saviour.

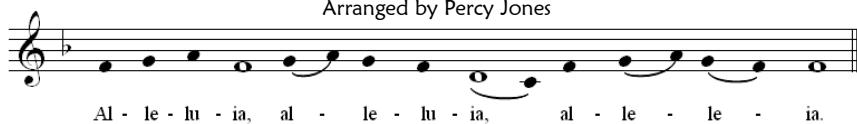
