you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us.

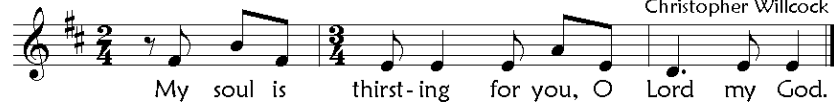
For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord,

My body pines for you like a dry, weary land without water.

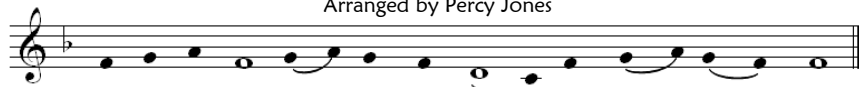
So I gaze on you in your dwelling to see your strength and glory.
