Enter God' presence filled with praise, enter with shouting and song.

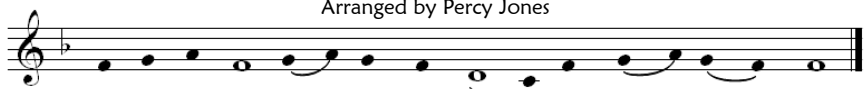
God cradles the depths of the earth, holds fast the mountain peaks.
