such as ministered to thee.

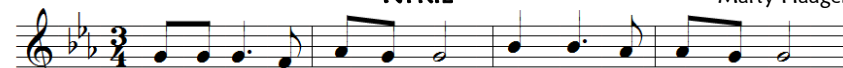

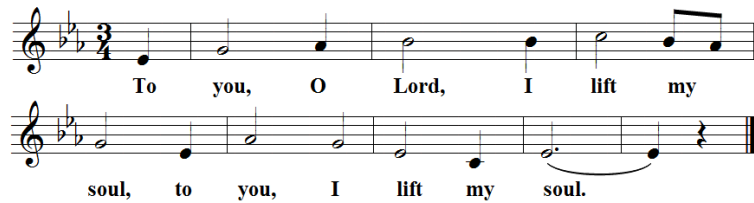

and keep me in the way of your truth, for you are my God, my Saviour.

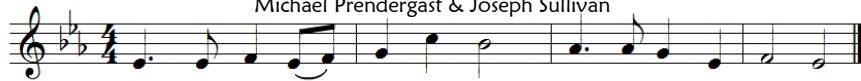
For the Lord is good and righteous,
