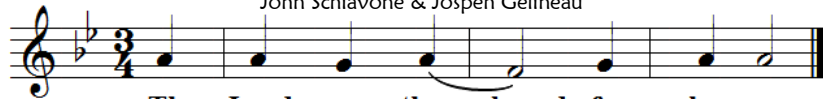
Glory to God in the highest,

The Lord gave them bread from heaven.

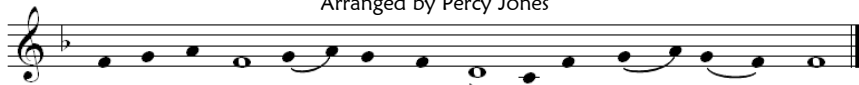
The things we have heard and understood, the things our fathers have told us,
